

VICTORIA SANDWICH

Ingredients:

3 eggs and their weight in:

- soft margarine
- caster sugar
- self- raising flour

One tablespoon hot water

Method

Cream margarine until like cream, add sugar and beat until white.

Add eggs one at a time with a good spoonful of flour.

Beat thoroughly.

Stir sifted flour quickly and add spoonful of hot water to mixture.

Turn into well greased and floured sandwich tins approx 7"- 8" diameter.

Bake in a moderate oven 20-30 mins, cool on a rack.
