

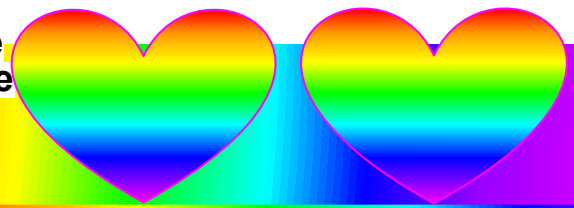
Wheelchair awareness day
